TAPA - TRANSPORTED ASSET PROTECTION ASSOCIATION

The Transported Asset Protection Association (TAPA) is an association of security professionals and related business partners from various manufacturing and transportation companies who have come together for the purpose of addressing the emerging security threats that are common to the relevant industries.

The TAPA standards and certifications have a measurably positive impact in reducing cargo crime. Major freight handlers are joining TAPA or employing TAPA security standards for facility or truck operations' certification.

TAPA has become a worldwide benchmark for security handling guidelines and practices. Businesses insurers are asking prospective customers about their security practices, and specifically whether they hold TAPA certification. Government agencies include TAPA endorsed standards in their development of homeland security initiatives.

TSR - TRUCKING SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

TSR has been established by TAPA's security professionals within the theft sensitive industry to address the nature by which theft sensitive products are transported over road.

The TSR specifies the minimum acceptable security standard and the methods to be used in maintaining those standards. It outlines the processes and specifications for Service Providers to attain TAPA certification for their truck operations. It is the intention of TAPA members to select Service Providers which meet or exceed TAPA certification requirements.

The TSR document is the official TAPA Standard for secure trucking services. It is a common global standard that can be used in business/security agreements between buyers and Logistics Service Providers (LSPs) and/or other applicants seeking certification.

Three classification levels (for vehicles reported in the Vehicle Register) are specified in the TSR:

- Level 1 = highest security protection
- Level 2 = mid level security protection
- Level 3 = lowest security protection
